EVENT DESCRIPTION

An online climate dialogue uniting communities, health professionals, youth and leaders to amplify climate action, resilience and environmental sustainability.

EVENT OVERVIEW

"The Climate Signal 2026" is a high-impact virtual observance organized by **Stevenson Holistic Care Foundation (SHCF)** to commemorate World Environment Day, 5th June 2026 in alignment with UNEP's global **#NowForClimate** campaign.

Inspired by the urgent signals being sent by the planet, rising temperatures, flooding, pollution, biodiversity loss and worsening health vulnerabilities, the event will spotlight climate action as both a moral responsibility and a public health necessity. The programme will bring together environmental experts, healthcare professionals, policymakers, youth leaders, development partners, media stakeholders and community advocates to amplify practical climate solutions, inspire behavioural change and strengthen collective action.

The event will also integrate UNEP's global creative movement by encouraging participants to share symbolic "climate signals" through short video messages, climate pledges, storytelling and the #NowForClimate social media campaign.

The Earth is sending signals louder than ever: rising temperatures, flooding, pollution, food insecurity and climate-related health risks are affecting communities globally and across Nigeria. Yet solutions are also rising: renewable energy, greener cities, ecosystem restoration, youth innovation and community resilience. However, the big question is, "To what extent are these rise"

To commemorate World Environment Day 2026, Stevenson Holistic Care Foundation will host a virtual event bringing together public health experts, environmental advocates, young people, policymakers, civil society organizations and community leaders to discuss practical climate solutions and collective responsibility.
